

Owned and operated by the Port of Olympia, our 66-acre terminal is situated on Budd Inlet at the head of Puget Sound.

We are centrally located to serve Puget Sound and the Columbia River Basin, providing ready access to local, regional and international markets.

The Port of Olympia is part of the Green Marine environmental certification program, making it one of the first 40 Port Authorities to do so globally, and the fourth regional Port.





Green Marine is a voluntary third-party certification program that requires participating port authorities to establish baseline performance indicators in multiple facets of Marine Terminal operations, and then demonstrate tangible year-over-year improvements to maintain certification. The certification system evaluates six distinct operational areas, including:



- Spill Prevention
- Dry Bulk Handling and Storage
- Community Impacts
- Environmental Leadership
- Waste Management
- Greenhouse Gases

DOCK FACILITIES

- Three modern, deepwater berths with a total length of 1,750 feet
- Load capacity of 1,000 lbs per square foot
- Direct discharge to rail
 - Berth height 21 feet







- Average tidal range 14 feet
- Water depth MLLW 39 feet
- Channel entrance approximately 30 feet of transit at MLLW
- Turning basin 800 feet





CRANE & EQUIPMENT

- 140 MT mobile harbor crane
- On-site container, bulk and breakbulk yard handling equipment including top-picks, yard tractors and chassis, front-end bucket loaders, forklifts, and log handlers
- Conveyor system for bulk cargoes
- Gatehouse and truck scales

TRANSPORTATION LINKS

Highway: One mile from Interstate 5.

Rail: On-dock rail service provided by Union Pacific and Burlington Northern Santa Fe railroads with switching service provided by Olympia & Belmore Railroad (a Genesee & Wyoming company).

- Rail car pusher
- 4 high capacity flat railcars for use inside and outside lease

Air: Olympia Regional Airport, 10 miles; Seattle-Tacoma International Airport, 60 miles.

Clearances:

- Tacoma Narrows Bridge 179 feet MHW
- Rail Union Pacific rail tunnels #25 and #26


Over 11,000 feet of Port-owned track including an on-dock loop track, warehouse siding and multiple storage tracks.


















WAREHOUSE

The on-dock 76,000 square foot, open beam construction facility has eight truck doors with self-leveling ramps, six drive-in doors with spans up to 78 feet wide and rail siding with a built-in fall arrest system with capacity to handle multiple cars.

- Adjacent to deepwater terminal only 175' from berth to warehouse
- Two offices on site
- Rail & truck served
- Suitable for multi-modal operations, including bulk conveyor operations
- Interior ceiling clearance height 24'




